About Hear Me Out

Hear Me Out is a small charity that uses music-making to support people held in immigration detention centres and related facilities like asylum hotels, and to build understanding and solidarity with people in the wider community. Most of our income is from grants, but we also rely increasingly on the generosity of individual supporters who share our vision and believe in the power of music to transform lives.

Role overview

We are seeking an experienced Individual Giving Consultant to support the continued growth and development of Hear Me Out's fundraising. Working one day per week on an ongoing basis, you will focus on building and strengthening relationships with individual supporters, running campaigns, developing new opportunities for giving, and ensuring we maximise income from this vital funding stream.

Key responsibilities

- Manage relationships with existing supporters, ensuring they feel valued and engaged.
- Grow the pool of individual donors through targeted campaigns, appeals, and stewardship.
- Increase the value of gifts from key existing donors.
- Support the development of major donor relationships, including cultivation, engagement, and asks
- Plan and deliver matched funding and other donor-led campaigns (e.g. The Big Give).
- Draft compelling communications and donor materials (letters, updates, campaign copy)
- Liaise with the Communications Manager on the creation of video and other materials for appeals.
- Monitor and evaluate progress against agreed targets, providing regular reports to the Director/Board.
- Work closely with the wider team to align fundraising activity with projects and organisational priorities.

Skills & experience

We are looking for someone who has:

• A proven track record of success in Individual Giving and/or major donor fundraising.

- Excellent communication and relationship-building skills.
- Experience in developing and delivering donor campaigns (e.g. matched funding, Big Give).
- Strong organisational skills, with the ability to manage priorities within limited time.
- Confidence in donor stewardship and making tailored, inspiring asks.
- A proactive, strategic approach with the ability to spot opportunities for growth.
- Passion for Hear Me Out's mission and values.
